February 13	First day for candidates to sign and file a public subsidy agreement.
February 14	Candidate filing period opens to run for office. Candidates must file a statement of economic interest within 14 days after filing for office.
February 15	Last day for candidates to file to run for office. Must file by 5 p.m.
February 15	Last day to raise contributions to qualify for public subsidy.
February 15	Last day of transactions to be included in the pre-special primary report of receipts and expenditures.
February 16	Last day for candidates to sign and file a public subsidy agreement.
February 16 through February 28	Reporting of Large Contributions – Pre-special primary Contributions and loans from any one source totaling more than \$500 must be reported to the Board electronically or in person by the end of the next business day after receipt and also on subsequent reports of receipts and expenditures for the special election cycle. Failure to file the notice on time will result in a \$50 per day late filing fee. Note: Candidates who are unopposed at the special primary do not need to report large contributions during this period.
February 22	Last day to file an affidavit of contributions to qualify for public subsidy.
February 22	Pre-special primary report of receipts and expenditures due (if there is a special primary). Period covered: January 1 through February 15, 2024.
February 23	\$50 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the pre-special primary report of receipts and expenditures.
February 29	PRIMARY ELECTION (if necessary)
March 5	Last day of transactions to be included in the pre-special general report of receipts and expenditures.
March 6 through March	Reporting of Large Contributions – Pre-special election Contributions and loans from any one source totaling more than \$500 must be reported

to the Board electronically or in person by the end of the next business day after receipt

and also on subsequent reports of receipts and expenditures for the special election

cycle. Failure to file the notice on time will result in a \$50 per day late filing fee. **Note:** Candidates who lost the special primary do not need to report large contributions during this period.

March 12 **Pre-special election report of receipts and expenditures due.** Period covered: January 1 through March 5, 2024.

March 19 SPECIAL ELECTION

- April 3 Public subsidy agreements expire for special election cycle.
- April 4 New Public Subsidy agreements may be signed.
- April 15 **Special election cycle final report of receipts and expenditures due.** Period covered: January 1 through April 3, 2024. **Note:** Candidates will be required to file a 2024 year-end report in addition to the special election cycle final report unless the special election cycle final report is a termination report.
- April 16 \$25 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the special election final report of receipts and expenditures.
